An Act to make provision consequential upon Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uganda attaining Independence

[5TH OCTOBER, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uganda Independence (Consequential Provisions) Act, 1962.

Short title and commencement

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation in relation to Jamaica on the sixth day of August, 1962, and in relation to Trinidad and Tobago on the thirty-first day of August, 1962, and shall come into operation in relation to Uganda on the ninth day of October, 1962.

2.—(1) This section shall be read as one with the Constitution.

(2) In addition to the countries set out in subsection (3) of section 7 of the Constitution, the said section 7 shall apply to Jamaica, to Trinidad and Tobago, and to Uganda.

Section 7 of the Constitution to apply to Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uganda

3.—(1) Where, before the appropriate date, any law in force in Tanganyika (including a law passed or made before the appropriate date which comes into operation thereafter) applied in relation to the Colony of Jamaica, the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago or the Protectorate of Uganda, or to persons or things in any way belonging to or connected with the said colonies or the said protectorate, such law shall continue to apply after the appropriate date, until provision is made to the contrary by the authority having power to alter that law, in relation to Jamaica, to Trinidad and Tobago, and to Uganda and to persons and things in any way belonging to or connected with Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uganda, notwithstanding that Jamaica and Trinidad and Tobago have ceased to be colonies and Uganda has ceased to be a protectorate.

Operation of existing law in relation to Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, and Uganda

(2) In this section the appropriate date in relation to Jamaica means the sixth day of August, 1962, in relation to Trinidad and Tobago means the thirty-first day of August, 1962, and in relation to Uganda means the ninth day of October, 1962.
