An Act to apply a further sum of eight hundred and sixty-three thousand, five hundred and twenty-one pounds out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, and to appropriate the supply granted

[2ND MARCH, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1961-1962) Act, 1962. Short title and construction

(2) The expressions used in this Act shall have the meanings respectively ascribed thereto in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1961. Ord. 1961 No. 21

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1962, the sum of eight hundred and sixty-three thousand, five hundred and twenty-one pounds. Issue of £863,521 out of consolidated fund

3. The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the amounts specified in the second and third columns of the Schedule to this Act. Appropriation of moneys voted

4. In addition to the sums granted out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2, there may be applied out of any moneys directed, under section 9 of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1961, to be applied as appropriations-in-aid, the amounts respectively set forth in the fourth column of the Schedule to this Act. Appropriations-in-aid

5.—(1) The Minister may at any time or times not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1962, borrow within or outside Tanganyika or partly within and partly outside Tanganyika any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole eight hundred and sixty-three thousand, five Power of the Minister to borrow
