**An Act to amend the Excise Tariff Ordinance**

[18TH SEPTEMBER, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanganyika and Zanzibar.

1. This Act may be cited as the Excise Tariff Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Excise Tariff Ordinance (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance").

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing section 6 thereof and substituting therefor the following new section:—

**Remission** 6.—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3 of this Ordinance the Minister may by order in the *Gazette* grant a remission of excise duty payable on such quantities of beer, wine and manufactured tobacco goods which are purchased, prior to delivery by the manufacturer thereof, by or on behalf of the Military Forces of the United Republic from non-public funds for the personal use of the members of such Forces as may be specified therein.

(2) The Minister may in any such order prescribe the limitations and conditions under which a remission of any excise duty payable may be made under this section.

(3) Any remission of any excise duty payable and made under this section, shall be granted by the Minister in accordance with the provisions of the Excise laws."
