An Act to amend the Forests Ordinance

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Forests Ordinance (Amendment) Short title Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Forests Ordinance.

2. The Forests Ordinance is hereby amended by adding, immediately New section below section 22, the following new section to be numbered 22A:— 22A inserted in Cap. 389

"Failure to comply with certain provisions of licences

- 22A. Any person to whom a licence has been granted under section 19 of this Ordinance who, in contravention of the conditions thereof—
 - (a) fails to take to a place which is specified in the licence as being a place for the measuring of forest produce, any forest produce which he has obtained under the terms of his licence; or
 - (b) (i) having taken forest produce to such specified place, carries away the same therefrom before it has been measured by a forest officer; or
 - (ii) in the case of forest produce consisting of a tree, timber or a pole, carries away such tree, timber or pole before a forest officer has both measured and marked the same with a prescribed mark,

shall be guilty of an offence against this Ordinance.".
