An Act to make special provisions for Pensions in Relation to Civil Servants who immediately before 1st July, 1965 were the Employees of the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation

[25TH JULY, 1970]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation Short title (Special Provisions Relating to Pensions) Act, 1970.

2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpreta-
tion

“Corporation” means the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation established by the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation Ordinance and dissolved by the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation (Dissolution) Act, 1965; Cap. 370

“Dissolution Act” means the Tanganyika Broadcasting Corporation (Dissolution) Act, 1965;

“employee of the Corporation” means any person—

- (a) who immediately before the commencement of the Dissolution Act was employed by the Corporation; and
- (b) who was subsequently appointed to the service of the United Republic on permanent and pensionable terms without any interval between the termination of his employment under the Corporation and his appointment to the service of the United Republic; and
- (c) who has been in continuous employment in the service of the United Republic until the coming into operation of this Act.

Special provisions relating to pensions

3.—(1) This section shall apply to every employee of the Corporation who was, when in the employment of the Corporation, a member of a pension scheme established by the Corporation.


(2) Every employee of the Corporation to whom this section applies shall be entitled to have his service in the Corporation for the specified period counted as pensionable, reckonable and gratuity-earning service for the purposes of the Pensions Ordinance as if his employment with the Corporation for such period was employment in the service of the United Republic on permanent and pensionable terms.

(3) For the purposes of this section, "specified period" in relation to any employee of the Corporation to whom this section applies means—

- (a) the period commencing on 1st July, 1963 and expiring on the date upon which the employment under the Corporation of such employee was terminated; or
- (b) the period commencing on the date on which such employee was first employed by the Corporation and expiring on the date on which his employment under the Corporation was terminated,

whichever is the shorter period.
