An Act to amend Certain Written Laws

[11th APRIL, 1974]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amend- Short title ments) (No. 1) Act, 1974.
2. The laws specified in the first and second columns of the Schedule Amendment hereto are amended in the manner specified opposite thereto in the third ^{of certain} column.

Cap. 508	The Judicial Service Act, 1962	Section 21b is amended in paragraph (c) of subsection (3) by deleting the words "Area Secretary" and substituting therefor the words "District Personnel Officer".
Cap. 537	The Magistrates' Courts Act, 1963	Section 5 is amended by adding the following subsection:— "(3) The Chief Justice may, if in his opinion it is in the public interest so to do, by order in the <i>Gazette</i> , confer upon a district court established for any district, jurisdiction over any other contiguous district or districts and where such order is made such district court shall have concurrent jurisdiction in relation to the district for which it is established and also in relation to such other district or districts as may be specified in such order."
Acts, 1969 No. 17	The Public Corporations Act, 1969	Section 2 is amended by deleting the definition "statutory corporation" and substituting therefor the following new definition:— "statutory corporation" means any body corporate (including a public corporation and a corporation sole) established by or under any written law but does not include— (a) any such body corporate established by any Act of the Community; (b) a company incorporated under the Companies Ordinance save where the whole of the share capital of such company is owned by a statutory corporation or two or more statutory corporations, and references in this paragraph to a statutory corporation include references to any other company the whole of the share capital of which is so owned."
