An Act to provide for an increase in the Number of Regional Commissioners who shall be Members of the National Assembly

[1ST JANUARY, 1974]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

WHEREAS subsection (1) of section 24 of the Interim Constitution of Tanzania, 1965, provides that seventeen Regional Commissioners appointed for the Regions in Tanganyika shall be Members of the National Assembly:

AND WHEREAS the President has increased the number of Regions in Tanganyika from eighteen to twenty:

AND WHEREAS subsection (3) of the said section 24 of the Interim Constitution provides that if the number of Regions is other than seventeen in Tanganyika, an Act of Parliament may provide for a corresponding increase or decrease in the number of Regional Commissioners who shall be Members of the National Assembly:

AND WHEREAS by the Interim Constitution (Increase in the Number of Regional Commissioners) Act, 1971 the number of Regional Com-Acts, 1971 missioners who shall be Members of Parliament was increased from seventeen to eighteen:

Now Therefore be it Enacted by the Parliament of the United Republic as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Interim Constitution (Increase in the Short title Number of Regional Commissioners) Act, 1974 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1974.

Increase in the number of Regional Com. missioners who shall be Members of Parliament

2. The number of Regional Commissioners appointed for Regions in Tangany ka who shall be Members of Parliament is hereby increased from eighteen to twenty and the provisions of the Interim Constitution as amended by the Interim Constitution (Increase in the Number of Regional Commissioners) Act, 1971 which provide for the eighteen Regional Commissioners appointed for the Regions in Tanganyika to be Members of Parliament and the provisions which refer to eighteen Regions of Tanganyika shall be read as if there were substituted for the word "eighteen" the word "twenty".
